#### 1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

At Julia Lee Performing Arts Academy, we believe that music education plays a vital role in student development by fostering creativity, discipline, and confidence. Prop 28 funding provides a meaningful opportunity to expand equitable access to music instruction for all students, particularly those who have historically lacked exposure to arts education. For the school year, JLPAA will use its Prop 28 allocation to build and strengthen our music program through a combination of staffing and instructional support. Approximately 80% or more of the funds will be used to hire a full-time credentialed music teacher to deliver weekly music instruction to students across all grade levels. Instruction will include general music education, rhythm and melody development, and introductory instrumental experiences. Students will participate in ensemble-based learning, with opportunities for performance and collaboration. Up to 20% of the funds will be used for essential materials and supports, including classroom instruments, sheet music, storage solutions, and staff professional development. The music curriculum will be aligned with California Arts Standards and include diverse musical styles to reflect and honor student backgrounds. Our program is designed to be inclusive, accessible, and sustainable. All students will participate in music during the school day at no cost to families. Over time, we plan to expand the scope of offerings to include after-school music enrichment and public performance opportunities. Prop 28 allows us to launch a high-quality music education program that is fully integrated into the academic life of our school, helping to close opportunity gaps while promoting creativity, self-expression, and school engagement for every student.
