D 2. IT Manager and Facilities Manager Monthly Report (Oral Report)

- 42% ELA students met or exceeded state standards, significant improvement
- Hired a Math Interventionist for middle school. 3.8% increase (state testing)
- Five staff will attend the California Assessment Conference this year
- Working with the company Guardian for additional student computer / chromebook security/safety.

D 3. Rising Stars (Oral Report)

- Partnered with Learn Fresh to include more math games: NBA Math Hoops, MLB Players STEM League & MLS STEM. 4th grade teachers receiving training on Learn Fresh products
- 50 students attending Padres game in San Diego Wednesday, 9/24/25. Linking trip to MLB game (Math intervention)
- Cup stacking team broke more records. 1st grader fastest in the Americas, invited to join official California team
- Tech-novation + \$9k grant making an impact teaching girls STEM & coding. Select staff attending training in San Francisco this school year

D 4. PBIS (Oral Update on PBIS)

- PBIS team has grown since implementation 2 years ago. Continuing to support teachers with student behaviors above tier 1, guiding some teachers on managing tier 1 situations in the classroom
- Partnered with 3rd party professionals to continue providing counseling in-person and virtually

D 5. Principal Monthly Report (Oral Report)

- Hired a Math Interventionist for middle school with a middle-high school teaching background to co-teach, support struggling students in small groups, and guide teachers with comprehensible math instruction
- Small group intervention has proven to be successful for reading & ELA
- Will be meeting with 8TH grade parents soon regarding behavior expectations and qualifications to participate in 8th grade end-of-year activities
- Principal's Café and ELPAC meeting coming soon
- Afterschool tutoring starting earlier this year (10week sessions).
